Eve's Return Statement

Most people only know Eve's conversation with the snake, the tragic fall and the curses that followed. But by the Grace of GOD, Eve did bounce back, devastations notwithstanding.

Genesis 4:25-26 (AMPC)

"And Adam's wife again became pregnant, and she bore a son and called his name Seth. She Said, "GOD has appointed for me another child instead of Abel, for Cain slew him." And to Seth also a son was born, whom he named Enosh. At that time Men Began To Call [upon God] by the name of the Lord."
